



Boatlift Safety Precautions & Warnings:

NOTICE: WHEN PURCHASING OR USING THIS PRODUCT YOU ARE AGREEING TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- 1) **Supervise children at all times:** Children must not be allowed to handle lift controls and cords.
- 2) **Stay alert:** Use common sense. Do not operate any product when tired. Don't operate any product if you are unsure of how to operate the product.
- 3) **Check for damaged parts:** Before using any product, any part that appears damaged should be carefully inspected to determine that it will operate correctly and perform its intended function. Check for proper alignment and binding parts. Take note of any broken components or mounting fixtures, **and have any issues immediately addressed by a qualified technician.** Do not use product if any switch does not turn **On** and **Off** correctly.
- 4) **Guard against electric shock:** Prevent body contact with grounded surfaces.
- 5) **Replacement parts and accessories:** When lift is being serviced, only **Floatair** parts and authorized technicians should be used to maintain warranty.
- 6) **Do not operate product if under the influence of alcohol or drugs:** Read **warning** labels if taking prescription medicine to determine if your judgment or reflexes are impaired while taking drugs. If there is any doubt, do not operate the product.
- 7) **When boat is stored for overnight or longer:** Make sure you have (4-2 at front and 2 at back) ropes tied to dock so that boat will not make contact when lift lowers or it is not in starting position. Spring lines and fenders should still be used to protect boat from dock and lift in the event the lift were to go down unexpectedly. (For example, someone stepped on a fitting causing a seal to break, or an animal chewed into a hose.)
- 8) **When boat is not on lift for a long period of time:** Leave in the up position. If you have a front mount or side mount lift make sure you **DO NOT OVERFILL THE LIFT** with too much air. If you are unsure how to raise the lift to the correct level when the lift is left without the boat on it for more than a week's period of time please contact your authorized dealer or the manufacturer and ask how to store your lift correctly and safely.
- 9) **Maintenance:** For your safety, service and maintenance should be performed regularly by a qualified Floatair technician. Floatair recommends having an inspection service done at least once a year by a qualified Floatair technician.

NOTICE: The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this safety manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into the product but must be supplied by the operator.
